C Instruments – Concert C = C

B \triangleright **Instruments** – Concert B \triangleright = C: count two notes to left (counter clockwise) on Circle of 4ths to find

your note from Concert Pitch (ie. Concert B_b = Your Written C)

E \flat **Instruments** – Concert E \flat = C: count three notes to left (counter clockwise) on Circle of 4ths to find

your note from Concert Pitch (ie. Concert B = Your Written G)

F Instruments – Concert F = C: count one note to left (counter clockwise) on Circle of 4ths to find

your note from Concert Pitch (ie. Concert B_{\flat} = Your Written F)

SATB Voicing Guide (Basic)

Soprano Instruments (S) – Piccolo, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet 1, Alto Saxophone 1, Trumpet 1

Alto Instruments (A) – Clarinet 2, Alto Saxophone 2, Trumpet 2 and 3, Horn 1

Tenor Instruments (T) – Clarinet 3, Tenor Saxophone, Horn 2, Trombone 1 and 2

Bass Instruments (B) - Bass Clarinet, Bassoon, Baritone Saxophone, Trombone 3, Euphonium, Tuba, Timpani

Percussion should distribute evenly the SAT parts between the various mallet instruments.
