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## ABOUT THE COMPOSER



Music by Larry Clark (b. 1963) is some of the most popular and most performed by concert bands and string orchestras of all ability levels. Larry is equally adept at writing music for beginners as he is for high school and college ensembles. His music is tuneful, contains a fresh harmonic perspective, is well scored and stretches the musicianship of the performers. He prides himself on producing music that is not only intriguing to performers and audiences alike but that contains a playability that comes from a keen understanding of the technical difficulties inherent in all instruments. His pieces have been performed internationally and appear on numerous contest/festival performance required music lists. He is an ASCAP award-winning composer, has over 300 publications in print and is in demand to write commissions for bands and orchestras across the country.

In addition to his abilities as a composer, Larry is the founder and President of Excelcia Music Publishing. His new company will focus on educational music for band, choral and orchestra along with related methods and books. Prior to Larry starting his own publishing company, he served for over eighteen years as Vice President, Editor-in-Chief for Carl Fischer Music, and before that, as Instrumental Music Editor for Warner Bros. Publications. Larry travels the world presenting clinics/workshops and guest conducting appearances. His background as a former middle school director and Director of Bands at Syracuse University, combined with his composing and editing, have placed Larry at the forefront of music for school ensembles. He holds a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Florida State University and Masters Degrees in Conducting and Composition from James Madison University in Virginia. ### ARS VITAE (ART IS LIFE)

*Ars Vitae* was commissioned by the Durham School of the Arts Band in Durham, NC. Conductors Allen Amos, Ken Davis, and Susan Townsend join in celebration of the 25th anniversary of the founding of the school.

*Ars Vitae* is Latin for “art is life”. Since the commission of this piece was to celebrate the 25th anniversary of an arts school, I felt it was a fitting title to celebrate the importance that the arts in general play in all of our lives. Without the arts, life would just be plain dull!

My inspiration for the piece was to create a celebratory work to honor the school’s anniversary, but also, I wanted there to be emotional moments as is presented in the lyrical middle section of the piece, where the range of emotions that music can portray is presented. The piece is built almost entirely out of the melodic material first stated in the first measure. Similar intervallic relationships are present throughout all of the main themes. The bold fanfare-like main theme should be contrasted in style and presentation with the more lyrical middle section of the piece that is still based on the same melodic fragment.

It is always my goal to use the full textural and timbral resources of the concert band as to give the piece variety, but also to afford each performer in the ensemble the opportunity to feel they are an integral part of the whole. The piece will work well as a concert opener or closer.

It has been my pleasure to have the opportunity to write this piece. I hope you and your students enjoy it and find it useful for your program.
